SUBJECT:

Creation of a team to study the applicability of the Proposed Guidelines to Improve the Delivery System of Logs from NRDC Logponds to various Sawmills and Logponds, and Documentation and Procedures to Eliminate/Minimize Various Forms of Log Smuggling.

1. In the interest of the service and in line with the forest conservation efforts of the government, a team is hereby created to study the procedures/guidelines recommended by NRDC to improve the delivery system of logs from NRDC to various sawmills and logponds, and documentation and procedures to eliminate/minimize various forms of log smmuggling. The study Team shall be composed of the following:

- 2. The Team shall test the recommended procedures on a pilot scale in an NRDC operation and a selected concession in Region 2 for a period not more than thirty (30) days.
- 3. A report of findings, comments and recommendations by the Team shall be submitted within thirty (30) days upon the completion of the study.
- 4. The NRDC, the timber concessionaire concerned, and the local DENR offices are instructed to provide active support to the team for the expiditious completion of the study.
- 5. All expenses required for the study is chargeable against the funds of the NRDC, and shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

6. This Order shall take effect immediately.
