Expenses to be incurred in connection herewith which include a) tuition fee, b) monthly stipend of ₱500, c) book allowance of ₱3,000 for the duration of the program, d) field trip expenses in the amount of ₱3,000 and e) research workshop fee of ₱900 will be provided for under such grant through the US-AID/TDI Project.

The scholars are required to devote full-time to their studies while on official leave with pay and to render three (3) years of service in the Department of Environment and Natural Resources after completion of the program.
