SUBJECT: Abolition of all Task Forces engaged
on the enforcement of forest laws,
rules and regulations

1. As a step towards the rationalization of the enforcement of laws, rules and regulations, all task forces previously created which are attached to the Office of the Minister and assigned to undertake the enforcement of forest and related laws, rules and regulations, are hereby abolished effective immediately.
2. All Bureau of Forest Development personnel affected by this Order shall clear themselves of all work, property and money responsibilities from their present assignments and shall report to the Director of the BFD for assignment and/or instructions as an exemption to the Minister's Memorandum Order dated 04 December 1986. Likewise, other personnel similarly affected herein shall report to their immediate superiors prior to their assignment to said task forces, for further instructions.
3. This Order shall take effect immediately and revokes MNR S.O. No. 137 dated April 7, 1986, MNR S.O. No. 451 dated August 11, 1986, MNR S.O. No. 612 dated October 7, 1986, MNR S.O. No. 296 dated June 17, 1986, Special Orders assigning certain personnel to the Task Forces/Units created by virtue of the aforestated Special Orders, and all orders and instructions inconsistent herewith.
