
SUBJECT : RIVERS REVIVAL PROGRAM:
PASIG RIVERSYSTEM REHABILITATION
PROJECT.

Cognizant of the economic, biological, social and historical significance of the Pasig Riversystem, and the need to rehabilitate the riversystem, the Director of the Lands Management Bureau and the Director-General of the National Mapping and Resources Information Authority are hereby jointly directed to form a composite team to:

1. Conduct a topographic survey of the Pasig riversystem from the mouth of the riversystem in Manila Bay to the Malacanang Palace at a scale of 1:2000 using a contour interval of 0.5 m;
2. Map-out locations of bridges, buildings and other major infrastructures within two blocks from the river banks;
3. Determine the heights of buildings and other major infrastructures;
4. Render periodic reports as to the status of the above to the Undersecretary for Environment and Research; and
5. Submit the outputs within three (3) months.

Expenses for this undertaking should be drawn from the regular operating budgets of the NAMRIA and LMB.
