1. 2. The Team shall perform the following tasks:

- a. determine the social and economic feasibility of the project to warrant nationwide replication;
- b. evaluate and assess the effects and impact of the project to the natural resources and communities in the area;


- c. recommend measures to improve project efficiency and effectiveness towards natural resources development, conservation and equity.

3. The Team shall be authorized to seek the assistance of any DENR official/personnel and to avail of any facilities or transportation services for the expeditious accomplishment of its tasks.

4. The Team shall submit report within five (5) days after the conduct of evaluation.

5. Funds for the purpose shall be chargeable against the allotment of the Office of the Secretary, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, in accordance with existing COA regulations.

6. This Order shall take effect immediately.
