SUBJECT: Assignment of Personnel at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA), Metro Manila.

1. In the interest of the service and in order to effectively regulate the exportation/importation as well as to stop smuggling or illegal trade of wild fauna and flora through the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA), Metro Manila, and pursuant to Executive Order No. 192 dated June 10, 1987 a team composed of the following PAWB personnel is hereby assigned thereat, to wit:

1. LORENZO C. AGALOOS - Supervisor
2. DEMOSTHENES C. RAMOS - Coordinator
3. FERNANDO Z. BOTARDO - Team Leader
4. GERONIMO TULLAS - Co-Team Leader
5. WILFREDO BONILLA - Member
6. ARNOLD BARONGO - Member
7. CESAR ROSALES - Member

2. They shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Promote and disseminate information on the conservation and protection of wildlife;
- b. Enforce existing wildlife laws, rules and regulations;
- c. Implement the provisions on export and monitor imports of plants and animals subject of CITES;
- d. Coordinate with other government agencies regarding the implementation of wildlife laws, rules and regulations; and
- e. Perform other functions as may be assigned by the Supervisor and/or the PAWB Director.

3. The Team shall man and be on duty in its Station at the NAIA seven (7) days a week, even outside regular office hours, specially during plane departures and/or arrivals;

4. The Supervisor and the Coordinator shall report to the Station at NAIIA at least once a week and twice a week, respectively, and/or substitute for personnel who may be absent from duty;

5. The Team shall be directly responsible to the Director of PAWB;


6. They shall submit a monthly accomplishment report to the PAWB Director stating the total number of wild plants and animals exported and/or imported, the number of apprehensions, if any, persons apprehended, name and quantity of wildlife/wild plants and status of the case and such of the pertinent datas or information as may be required by higher authorities;

7. They shall continue to be entitled to claim reasonable transportation expenses, per diems and monthly allowances granted under Memorandum of the Secretary of Natural Resources to the OIC, Director, Bureau of Forest Development, Diliman, Quezon City, dated February 27, 1987, effective January 1, 1988 in lieu of overtime to defray their additional expenditures in the performance of their work and other incidental expenses, subject to COA rules and regulations, chargeable against the funds intended for the purpose;

8. They are hereby authorized to engaged the services of, and/or seek assistance from any other government law enforcement agencies in carrying out this Order.


9. All seized wildlife, including stuffed animals and wild plants, shall be deposited at the Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife Nature Center (NAPWNC), Quezon City for safekeeping, care and maintenance; and

10. This Order shall take effect immediately and supersedes all previous orders inconsistent herewith.
