SUBJECT: CREATION OF AN AD-HOC STUDY COMMITTEE, FIELD IMPLEMENTATION GROUP, AND SECRETARIAT TO IMPLEMENT, MONITOR AND ASSES THE TIMBER PRODUCTION SHARING AGREEMENT PILOT PROJECT.


1. In the interest of the service and to ensure the effective utilization of our forest resources as an instrument to economic recovery and national security, through co-production, joint venture or production sharing agreement, pursuant to Executive Order No. 278, an ad-hoc TPSA Pilot Study Committee is hereby created, composed of the following:

2. The Committee shall have the following functions:
 - 2.1 Supervise the preparation of the research and operations plan for the Pilot TPSA project covering an area of 400 hectares of forest land located at Nagtipunan, Quirino.
 - 2.2 Prescribe the desired evaluation standards, measures of performance and parameters by which the pilot project may be assessed;
 - 2.3 Direct and supervise the collection, evaluation and analysis of the project study and information;
 - 2.4 Coordinate the activities of the Field Implementation Group and the Secretariat;
 - 2.5 Submit to the Secretary periodic assessment report;
 - 2.6 Recommend to the Secretary termination or extension of the Agreement as the case may be.
 - 2.7 Formulate and submit to the Secretary the recommended set guidelines/standards for subsequent regular TPSA issuances; and

- 2.8 Perform other duties as may be prescribed by the Secretary.
3. The Committee shall be assisted by a Secretariat to be composed of:

5. The Field Implementation Group shall have the following functions:
- 5.1 Prepare and implement the research and operations plan for the pilot study area, in coordination with the second party;
 - 5.2 Collect, validate and evaluate performance data and information on the standards, measures and parameters set by the Committee;
 - 5.3 Periodically submit to the Committee performance/accomplishment reports;
 - 5.4 Prepare and submit to the Committee a comprehensive terminal report within two (2) weeks after the completion of the project study; and
 - 5.5 Perform other duties as may be prescribed by the Committee.
6. Ad-Hoc Committee, Secretariat and Field Implementation Group shall perform their functions for a period co-terminus with the duration of the TPSA entered into with Bagabag Sawmill Corporation.
7. The Committee is hereby authorized to call on DENR personnel, other government offices and the private sector to assist in the exercise of the aforesaid functions.
8. The members of the Study Committee, Secretariat and Field Implementations Group are hereby authorized to collect allowances and per diems chargeable against NRDC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
9. This order takes effect immediately.
