DENR Special Order No. 296 Series of 1988

SUBJECT: Assigning Action Officers to organize

and mobilize the Community Environment and Natural Resources Offices (CENRO)

<u>in Region I</u>

In the interest of the service and pursuant to the mandates of Executive Order No. 192, Series of 1987 and by virtue of the authority granted to the Assistant Secretaries for Regional Operations under the Memorandum of the Undersecretary for Field Operations dated March 30,1988, the following are assigned to organize and mobilize the Community Environment and Natural Resources Offices (CENRO) in the Municipalities/Cities indicated opposite their names in Region I, to wit:

The above indicated CENRO sites are tentative and subject to final recommendation per procedure and quidelines of site selection earlier indicated.

The above officers, in consultation with the Regional Management Committee and the PENRO Action Officers, shall undertake the following:

- a. Plan and propose an office site and facilities plan and prepare a CENRO operations plan for immediate activation. Identify problems relative to the transfer of office.
- b. Study, evaluate and submit a plan matching qualified personnel with the CENRO plantilla.
- preparing the PENRO Action Officer in c. Assist administrative and finance transition plan.



- d. Recommend a community work and financial plan in consonance with the regional and provincial plans.
- e. Identify priority environment and natural resources related problems and issues affecting the locality.
- f. Identify existing and immediately mobilizable priority projects.

To effectively comply with the above tasks, the assigned officers shall be authorized to mobilize and tap any of the district personnel taking care that delays and disturbances in the regula@ service to the public is avoided. Personnel needed on full time assignment to assist in setting up the office must have an explicit approval of the Regional Executive Director.

The above officers are to take further instructions from their Regional Executive Director regarding other authorities needed in handling their assigned tasks. They are to submit their plans to the Regional Management Committee within one month from date hereof and present their accomplishment reports within three months.

Expenses to be incurred in the mobilization and organization of CENRO Offices shall be chargeable against the respective allotment of the office to be absorbed by the CENRO.

The above officers, including all other personnel who will be assigned to assist them, shall continue to receive their salaries from their respective mother units under hold-over capacity.

These designations do not entitle them priority rights for promotions and/or appointment.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in effect until revoked by the undersigned or superseded by higher authorities.
