- 2. Each team is tasked to identify suitable and adequate sites; assess and evaluate the area including probable community proponents; conduct forest resources inventory; and assist in the preparation of management and development plans.
- 3. They shall report to the Task Force Coordinator, Office of the Undersecretary for Field Operation for briefing and further instructions. They shall also be guided by Community Forest Management Project Manual of Operations.
- 4. All expenses incurred in the performance of work, duties and responsibilities shall be charged against DENR Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. This Order takes effect immediately and shall be terminated upon completion of the assigned tasks.
