SUBJECT : Designating Remedios Evangelista as Process Monitoring Supervisor; Angelita Racelis and Rosalie Imperial as Process Monitors for Liquicia, Caba, La Union, Sos. Bianque and Patal-Bangkal, Malomboy, Zambales and Malan-oq, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro under the DENR-Upland Development Program Limited Expansion Stage Process Monitoring Research.

1. In the interest of the service and consistent with the department's thrust of upgrading institutional capability to undertake activities aimed at developing more effective approaches to upland development, the above-named personnel Social Forestry Division-Forest Management Bureau are hereby designated to carry-out the tasks outlined.


2. Together with the Process Monitoring Supervisor and with assistance from the UDP-Technical Officer for Process Monitoring Research, they are to perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. systematically document community activities, events and issues, following processual approaches, relative to the implementation of the said projects;
- b. assist the agency as members of the Regional Upland Development Committees concerned to identify policy issues, management decisions and implementation procedures that affect the operations of the projects;
- c. provide feedbacks at the regional and field levels as to the effectivity of the model proposed within the implementation manual of ISFP; and
- d. submit reports detailing the above activities to the Upland Development Working Group for its information and proper usage.

3. They shall be relieved of other work assignments inconsistent with this order and shall immediately inform this office of their compliance upon receipt hereof.

4. They shall be entitled to a reasonable subsistence allowance; traveling and other incidental expenses incurred in the compliance of this order shall be charged to the DENR Upland Development Trust Fund.

5. This Order takes effect immediately and supersedes all previous orders and instructions inconsistent herewith.
