SUBJECT: Creating and organizing a DENR Task Force to attend the land problems in the Boso-Boso Area, in Barangay San Jose, Antipolo, Rizal.

1. In accordance with the agreement reached during the coordinative conference held on October 2, 1989 relative to the land problems in the Marikina Watershed more particularly in the Boso-Boso Area in Barangay San Jose, Antipolo, Rizal, and considering that the Department of National Defense (DND) is setting-up a counterpart AFP Security Task Force to assist the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in its peace-keeping efforts in the Area, a DENR Task Force is hereby created and organized to handle the legal and administrative aspects of the problem, composed of the following:

2. As constituted, the DENR Task Force shall have the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

- a. To study and take legal actions in consultation with higher authorities in the Department, to prevent further complications of the Boso-Boso land problems;
- b. To prosecute to successful ends all pending cases affecting the Area and to institute immediate legal actions against any and all persons or entities violating any of the existing laws, rules and regulations relevant to the administration of the same by the Government;
- c. To provide comprehensive protection to existing forest cover in the Marikina Watershed, to existing forest plantations either by the government or by private awardees of CSCs or reforestation contracts, and to any existing government facilities in the Area; and to coordinate with and seek the assistance of the AFP Security Task Force on the matter.

- d. To coordinate with the PENRO and CENRO Offices in the province in the prompt execution of DENR orders and directives and in the implementation of appropriate programs and projects in the Area;
- e. To carry out all instructions which may be issued by the DENR from time to time; and to perform any and all acts implicit in the creation of the Task Force, which are necessary to contain and solve the Boso-Boso land problems.


3. In the performance of its functions, duties and responsibilities the Task Force is hereby authorized to call on any official and employee of the Department for support or assistance it may need.

4. The PENRO and CENRO of Rizal are hereby directed to immediately set-up a Field Station therein, with at least one responsible officer, to be on hand, on rotation basis, for a round-the-clock 24-hour duty, where the people can run for any service assistance.

5. The CENRO should further coordinate with the AFP Security Task Force to set-up a common checkpoint at a critical entrance to Boso-Boso.

6. The Chairman and team members are entitled to travelling expenses subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. This Order is in the interest of the service and takes effect immediately.
