SUBJECT : Designating Assistant Secretary
Bernardo C. Agaloos as National
Coordinator for DENR's Pro-Poor
Projects.

In the interest of the service and pursuant to the DENR's contribution towards the Government's Pro-Poor Program, Assistant Secretary Bernardo C. Agaloos is hereby designated as National Coordinator of the Department's High Impact Projects for the 100 poorest towns in the Philippines.

As National Coordinator, he shall have the following responsibilities and authorities :

1. Coordinate the implementation of the different High Impact Projects identified and proposed for implementation by each DENR Regional Office;
2. Undertake measures and issue instructions to the REDs and other field officials to ensure the successful implementation of their high impact projects;
3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the different projects by the field offices;
4. Prepare quarterly reports on the progress and accomplishments of the different Regional Projects for the Secretary;
5. Call on any DENR personnel, whether Central or field based, for assistance and support in the performance of his functions and duties;


6. He shall be supported by the ISFP National and Regional Coordinating Staff, whose services may be required by him.
7. Expenses in connection with the performance of his functions under the Special Order and necessary support staff, shall be charged against the Office of the Secretary, under General Administration and Supervision.

This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in forces until revoked by the proper authority.
