SUBJECT : Designating DENR Field Personnel as
Community Organizing Coordinators for
each Island grouping under the DENR-
Upland Development Program Limited
Expansion Stage .

1. In the interest of the service and consistent with the department's efforts to strengthen its capabilities to efficiently and effectively implement its vision of upland development through participatory strategies, the following personnel are hereby designated as Community Organizing Coordinators for each Island grouping under the DENR-Upland Development Program Limited Expansion Stage.

2. As such, and under the supervision of the UDF Technical Officer for Community Organizing, they are perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. work closely with the Philippine Business for Social Progress'-designated Senior Technical Officer in carrying-out his duties and responsibilities as outlined under the agreement signed between the DENR and the PBSP's-Center for Rural Technology Development on Community Organizing Technical Assistance Program;
- b. assist the designated Forest Community Organizer (FCO) in his area of assignment whenever necessary, in performing his duties and responsibilities outlined under DENR Special Order issued for the same purpose;


- c. conduct field visits, monitoring and evaluation and on-site strategizing sessions with the FCOs; and
- d. perform other functions as may be assigned by higher authorities.

3. They are to be relieved of all work assignments inconsistent with this order and clear themselves of property and financial obligations from their present place of assignment.

4. They are entitled to a reasonable subsistence allowance, Traveling and other incidental expenses in compliance with this order chargeable againsts the PBSP-Center for Rural Technology Development contract and to the DENR, Upland Development Trust Fund as the case warrants.

5. They are to inform this office of their compliance to this order and report immediately to the respective Assistant Secretary for Field Operations in each Island Group seven (7) days upon receipt hereof.

6. This Order takes effect immediately and supersedes all others inconsistent herewith.
