SUBJECT: Creation of the Regional Coordinating Committee of the Natural Resources Management and Development Project (NRMDP)

For the effective coordination and assessment of the NRMDP activities in pilot regions and study areas as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding dated January 25, 1989, there is hereby created a Regional Coordinating Committee (RCC) in Regions II, III and VII.

These RCCs shall be composed of the following DENR officials and regional representatives of government agencies involved in the implementation of NRMDP:


1. Regional Executive Director ----- Chairman

2. Regional Executive Director ----- Member
National Economic and Development Authority
3. Regional Director ----- Member
Department of Agrarian Reform
4. Register of Deeds ----- Member
Land Registration Administration
5. Regional Assessor ----- Member
Department of Finance
6. Regional Director ----- Member
Department of Agriculture
7. Provincial Planner ----- Member
8. Local Government Representative ----- Member
9. Regional Technical Director, DENR
assigned as Project Coordinator ----- Member
10. Assistant Secretary for Operations ----- Adviser
Dept. of Environment and Natural Resources

The above-mentioned officials shall perform the following functions:

1. Ensure the proper coordination of NRMDF activities in the region.
2. Regularly assess project accomplishment vis-a-vis work programs in their respective regions.
3. Ensure the cooperation of local governments at the regional and pilot areas.
4. Bring to the attention of the PGB and/or Project Management Office issues affecting the efficient and effective implementation of the project's activities.

In the performance of the above functions, the above-cited officials are entitled to a monthly honorarium effective April 1989 chargeable against NRMDF funds subject to fund availability and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. In view, however, of standing DENR policies, the above officials from the DENR shall not be entitled to said monthly honoraria.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing by the undersigned.
