Under this Order, the participants from the regional field offices are hereby authorized to claim two-way transportation expense and per diems while on travel to and from the training venue, chargeable against the appropriations of their respective regions subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Those coming from the DENR proper shall be entitled only to a two-way transportation expense chargeable against FASPO funds in accordance with the usual accounting and auditing restrictions.

This Order requires the administrative support staff to take charge of the proper documentation of the activity and of ensuring the successful conduct of the training. Said staff is also expected to prepare a summary report to be submitted to the undersigned within two (2) weeks after completion of the training.
