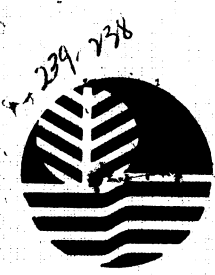


After the training, participants should have acquired the following skills:

1. Expertise in the use of barangay maps needed in the conduct of the Inventory of Forest Occupants (IFO);
2. Ability to demonstrate proper attitudes in dealing with forest occupants;
3. Mastery in filling up IFO forms and questionnaires; and
4. Familiarity of operational guidelines and procedures.

The above mentioned participants shall act as resource persons in Level II & III training scheduled on 10-14 April 1989 and April 17-21, respectively.
