DENR SPECIAL ORDER

SUBJECT: Creation of National and Regional
Executive Committees for the Adopt a
Tree, Adopt a Mining Forest Movement

Pursuant to the DENR Administrative Order No. 22
Series of 1989, there is hereby created National and
Regional Executive Committees for the Adopt a Tree,
Adopt a Mining Forest Movement that shall be responsible
for the management of the said Movement to ensure its
effective implementation.

In managing the Adopt a Tree, Adopt a Mining Forest
Movement, the National Executive Committee shall take
charge of planning and research works, set pertinent
rules and regulations, formulate the criteria for the
"Best Mining Forest" Contest and determine the winners
thereof based on such criteria.

The Regional Executive Committee shall be formed in
each regional office of the DENR to assist the National
Executive Committee in performing the latter's tasks as
may be required and supervise/direct the activities of
the Mining Forest Assistance Team created under Section
V-A of the above Administrative Order.

The composition of these Committees shall be as
follows:

National Executive Committee

Chairman : Director of Mines and Geo-Sciences
Vice Chairman: Asst. Director of Forest Manage-
ment Bureau
Members : One (1) Personnel each from the
Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau,
Forest Management Bureau, DENR
Special Concerns Office and Field
Operations Office (to be designated
by the respective heads of said
offices)

Regional Executive Committee

- Chairman : Regional Technical Director for Mines Sector (or Mineral Operations Officer for regions without RTDs for Mines Sector)
- Members : All Provincial Natural Resources Officers within the region concerned

The National Executive Committee shall also be assisted by a Technical Secretariat that shall be responsible for monitoring of the Movement participants' activities, data gathering, record custody, maintaining liaison with the Regional Executive Committees and Mining Forest Assistant Teams and undertaking other related activities as may be assigned by the said Committee. It shall be composed of the following personnel from the Movement's lead agency (MGB):

- Head : Chief of Mine Technology Division
- Asst. Head: Chief of Mine Safety Coordination Section, MTD
- Members : All Personnel of the Mine Safety Coordination Section, MTD

This Order takes effect immediately and supercedes all other pertinent Special Orders found inconsistent with it.
