SUBJECT : Creation of a Team to Conduct an Inventory of Equipments of the Calauit and Tamaraw Special Projects from May 4-13, 1989

In the interest of the service and in view of the need to review and renegotiate the existing management contract of the DENR with the Conservation Resource and Management Foundation (CRMF) in the implementation of the Calauit and Tamaraw Projects, a Team is hereby created which shall be composed of the following:

The team shall be specifically charged with the following duties and functions:

Conduct an inventory of equipments acquired and/or purchased and infrastructure constructed in the project site;

- 2. conduct an inventory as to the number of forest occupants and the number of communities in the reservation area including Tamaraw population;
- 3. identify problems arising from the implementation of the projects.

The team shall submit an inventory report of the two mentioned projects including financial statements with corresponding breakdown of expenses to this Office ten (10) days after completion of travel.

Expenses to be incurred shall be charged against the appropriation of their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until the completion of the assigned task.
