

5. AD Lope Reyes

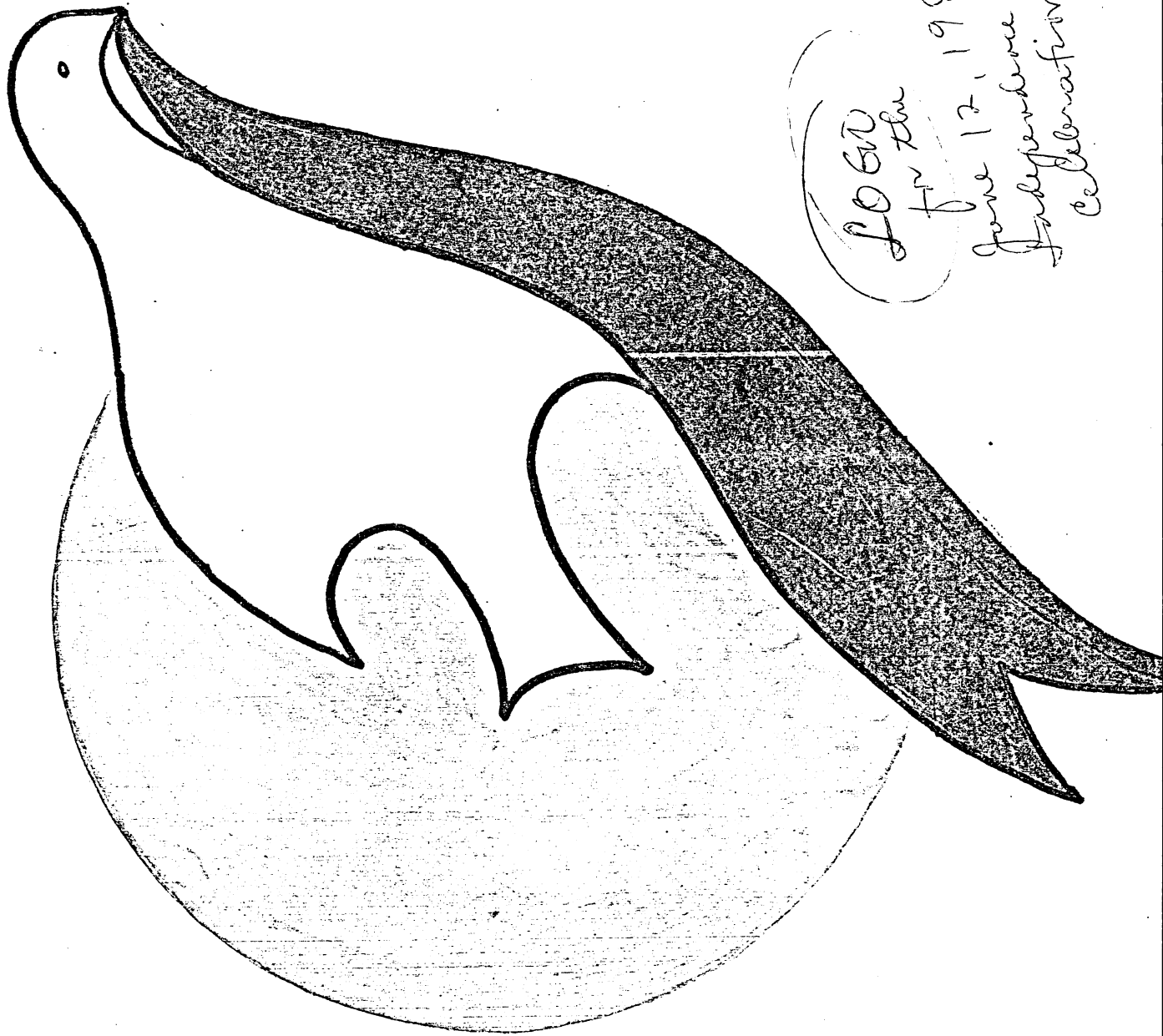
The functions of the marshalls, the schedules of activities and the lay-out for the parade are indicated in the attached document.

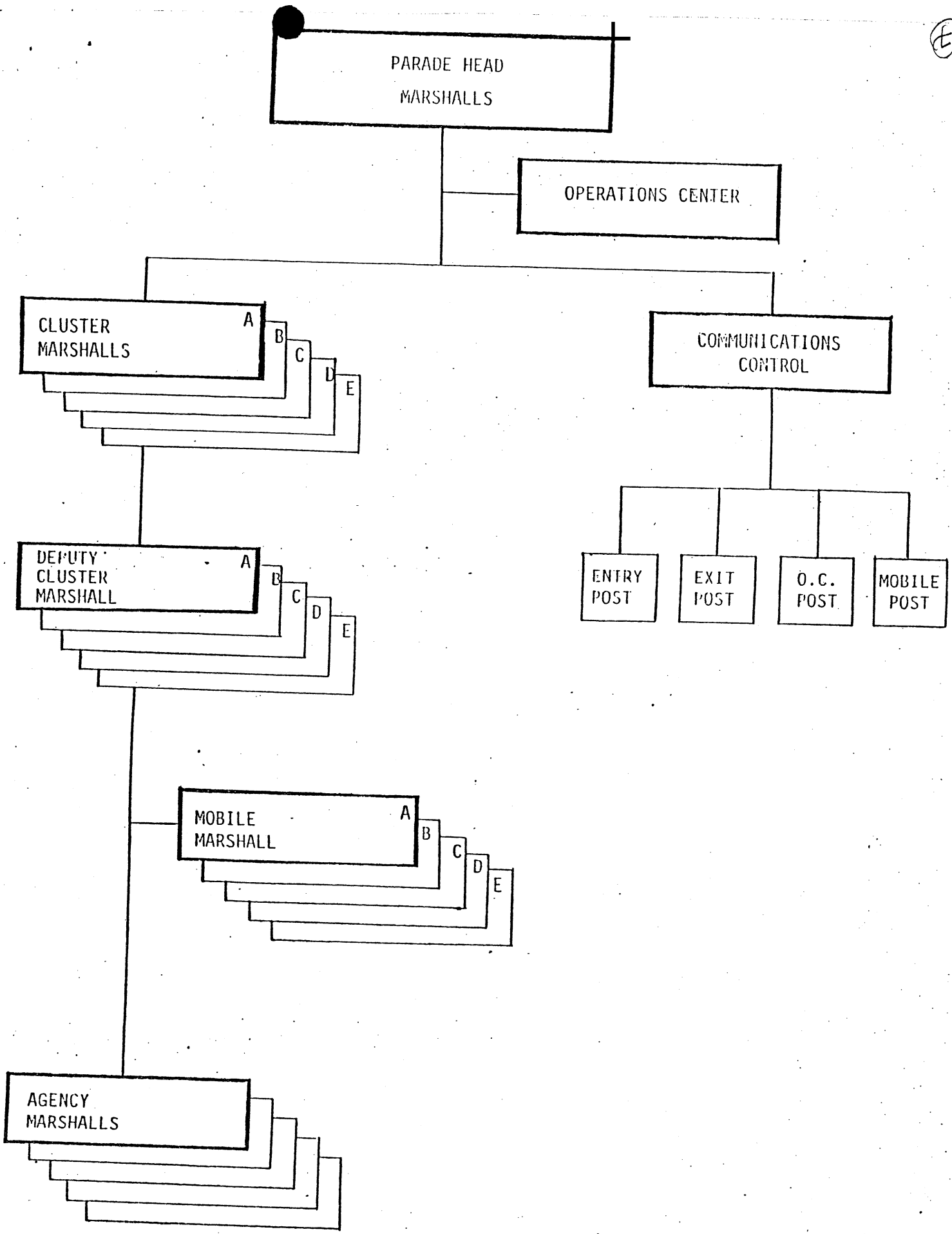

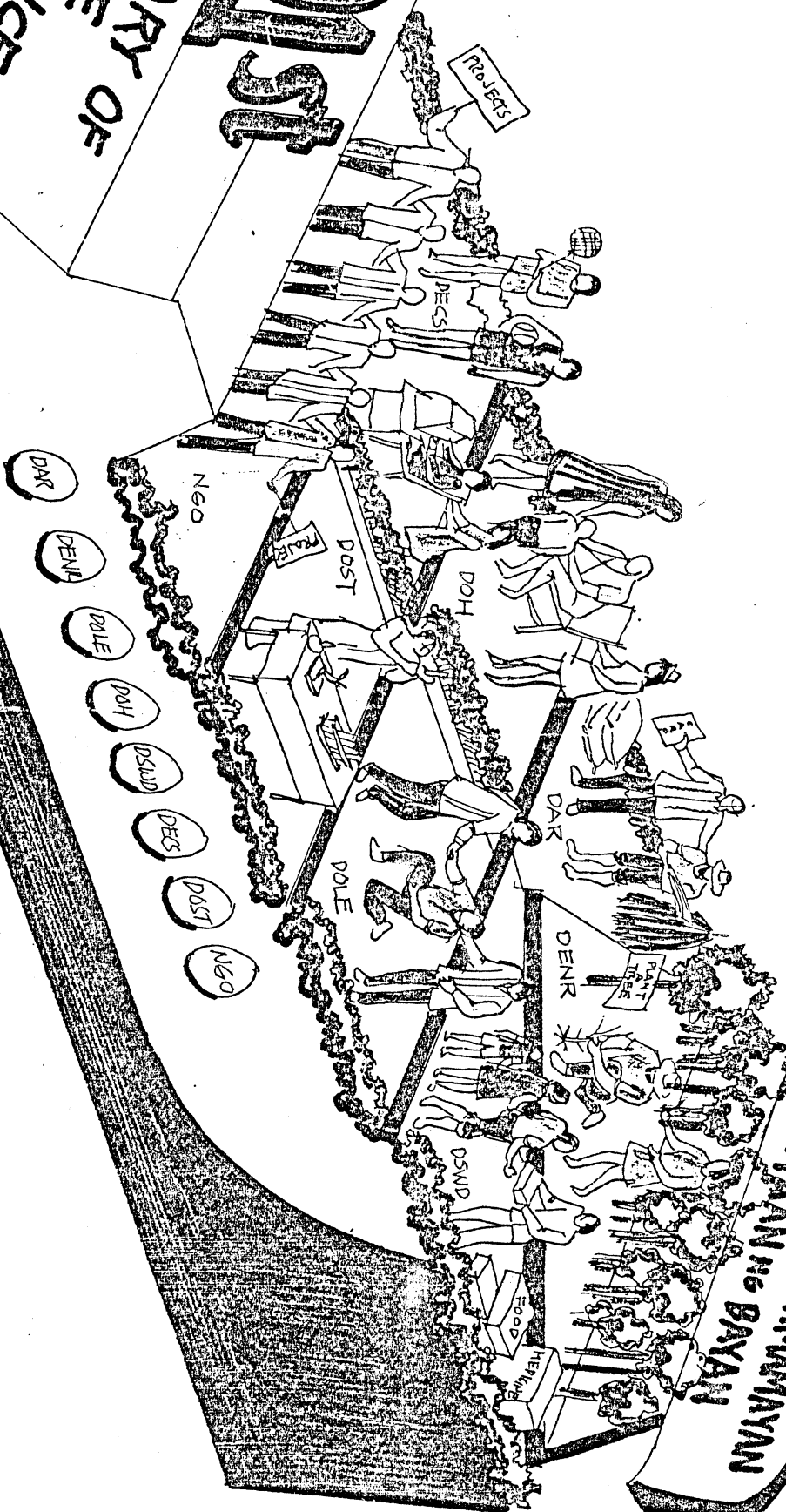

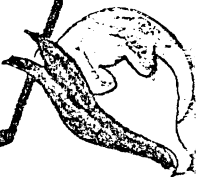

GUIDELINES:

- A. There will be five (5) Clusters, namely: 1) Lead Cluster; 2) Economic Cluster; 3) Social Cluster; 4) Political Cluster and 5) Kalayaan Cluster. Each will be headed by a Cluster Marshall.
- B. Each Cluster will be composed of Government Agencies and NGOs. A lead agency will be responsible in organizing the Cluster.
- C. Each Cluster includes an agency which shall be responsible for the Float.
- D. Each Cluster shall have a Cluster Marshall and a Deputy Marshall.
- E. Each member-agency shall have five (5) Agency Marshalls.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

A. CLUSTER HEADS/MARSHALLS

- 1. Act as overall coordinators and marshalls of the Cluster.
- 2. Coordinate with Cluster in-charge for the purpose of monitoring and coordinating the activities of member agencies of the cluster.
- 3. Coordinate with the agency in-charge of the Float to ensure the proper positioning of the float during the parade assembly.
- 4. Issue invitations and relay pertinent information to member-agencies emanating from the Parade Committee.
- 5. Responsible for the participation of member-agencies during dry-run and the actual parade.
- 6. Usher participating member-agencies to respective designated assembly area.
- 7. See to it that participants reach their assigned area/destination on time.
- 8. Arrange for the appointment of Deputy Cluster Marshall and Agency Marshalls who shall be responsible for the orderly assembly and conduct of the parade. The Head Marshall shall coordinate the activities of the lower marshalls.

9. Check and monitor to the Police/Military any untoward activity, demonstration, display of irrelevant/subversive placards. Interface with the Police/Military on crowd control.
10. Maintain order and discipline in the Cluster during the parade.
11. Interface with other Committees to ensure the systematic and orderly conduct of activities.
12. See to it that all parade components, paraphernalia, band, float, etc. are in place.

B. FLOAT

Agency In-Charge

1. Design motif in line with the Cluster sectoral thrust and within the framework of the celebration THEME to be presented to the Cluster members for approval.
2. Coordinates with the DPWH, the Cluster and Parade Committees.
3. Assumes responsibility for the final preparation of the Float such as people to ride on the float, their costumes, decorations, props, etc.

DPWH

1. Responsible for the preparation of the float carriage/flat beds (vehicles) and frameworks.
2. Provide driver, gasoline and oil for the float carriage (vehicle).

C. AGENCY IN-CHARGE OF CLUSTER

1. Responsible for the organization of the member-agencies of the Cluster and their participation in the parade.
2. Responsible for the coordination with the various committees or groups for the cluster's assembly time, assembly area, parking area and such other information.
3. Ensure the avallment of paraphernalia from Parade Committee and other groups.
4. Decide on their own "pakulo" and uniforms.

D. MEMBER-AGENCIES

1. Appoint their respective Agency Marshalls and their Assistants and submit their names to the Parade (Head) Marshall, c/o the Parade Committee. *c/o Asee Polly Martin*
- di. ✓* 2. Identify, coordinate and organize their NGOs and ensure their participation. *c/o Lira H.*
- di. ✓* 3. Arrange for the appointment of five (5) marshalls for their counterpart NGO. *c/o Lira H.*
4. Prepare and carry their respective agency streamers (Standard size: 1M x 8M). *1 x 8 meters* *c/o Asee Polly*
5. Inform their footmarchers of the prescribed uniform as agreed upon by the cluster. *c/o Lira H. and Linda Dawson*
6. Ensure availment of vehicle passes, security tags or ribbons for the individual members and NGOs. *c/o Lira H.*

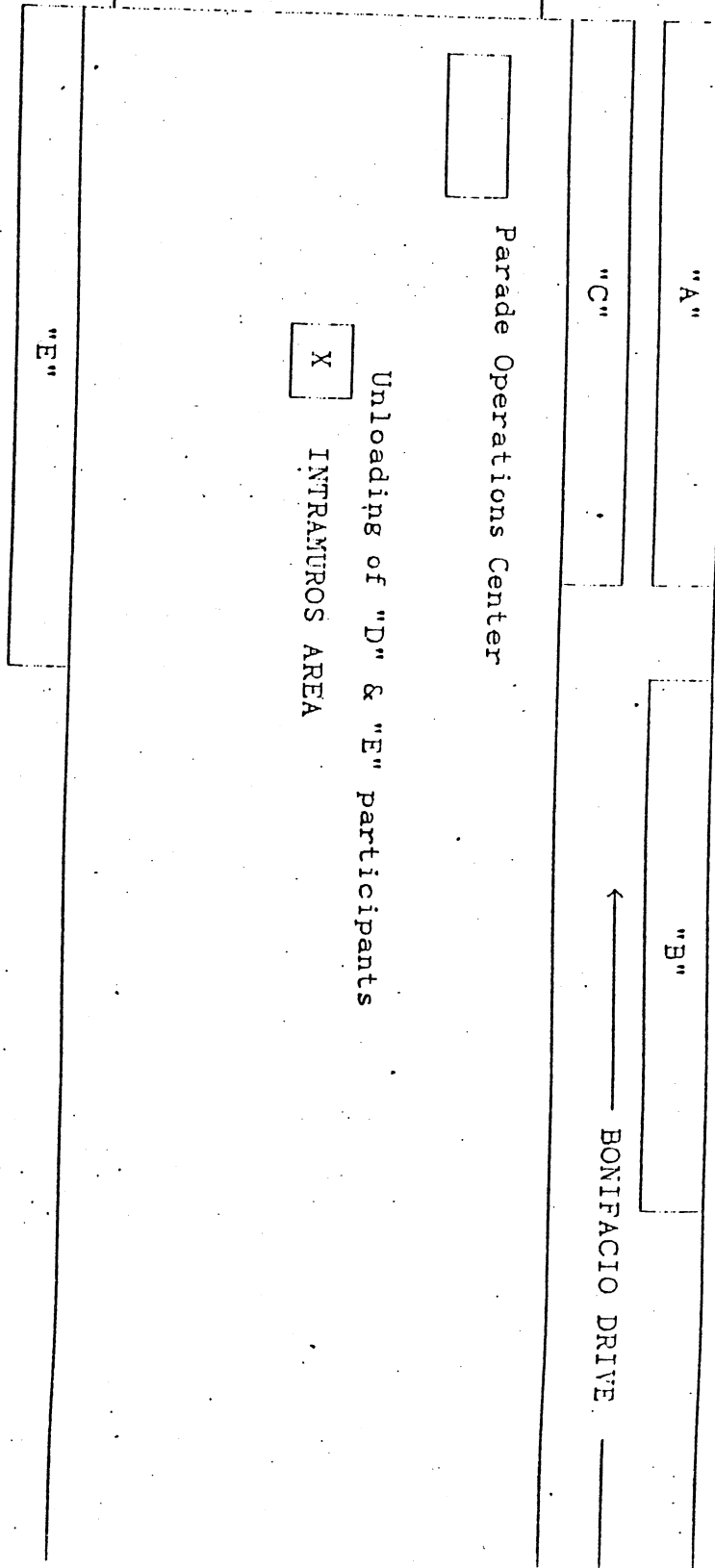
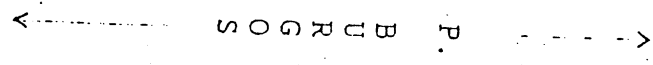

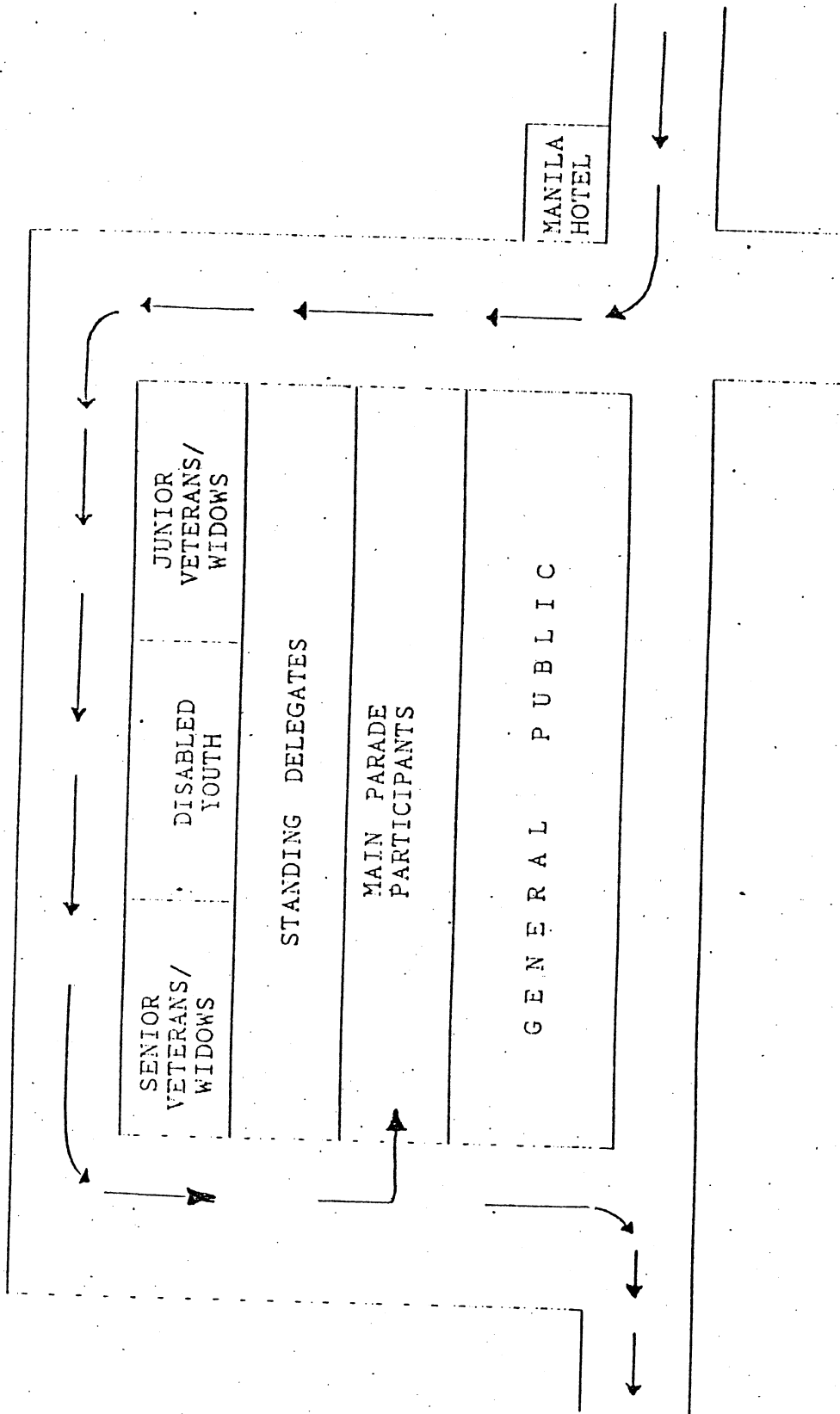
