





SPECIAL ORDER

SUBJECT: Amendment to Special Order No. 198
designating Ms. Leah J. de Leon of
ECD-EASPC and Mr. Edgar A. Saniel
of RAMD-EASPC as permanent Special
Disbursing Officers of the RP-Japan
Crocodile Farming Institute.

1. In the interest of the service Special Disbursing Officers Ms. Leah J. de Leon and Mr. Edgar A. Saniel are authorized to handle cash advances not to exceed SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P700,000.00) each.
2. As Special Disbursing Officers, Ms. de Leon and Mr. Saniel shall take charge of the Personnel Services (01), Capital Outlay (300) and Operating Expenses as follows: Communication Services (03); Repair of government facilities (04); Transportation/Handling Expenses (05); Other Services (06); Supplies and Materials (07); Maintenance of Motor Vehicles (17-000); and Representation Expenses (19).
3. As Special Disbursing Officers, Ms. de Leon and Mr. Saniel are also authorized to handle cash advances to cover Miscellaneous Expenses in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) each.
4. All expenses incurred by Ms. de Leon and Mr. Saniel in the execution of their official functions shall be charged against the RP-Japan Crocodile Farming Institute funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. This order shall not entitle Ms. de Leon and Mr. Saniel to preferential rights to promotion.
6. This order shall take effect immediately.
