SUBJECT : Creation of a Team to investigate the reported alleged issuance of titles in Tipo, Hermosa, Bataan within the Roosevelt National Park

In connection with reports reaching this Office on the existence of persons claiming ownership of a portion of the Roosevelt National Park situated in Tipo, Hermosa, Bataan and allegedly selling these lands to the actual occupants thereof, an Investigating Team is hereby created composed of the following:

The Team Leader may call on the services of other personnel of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office and the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office, as the need arises, during the conduct of the investigation.

The Investigating Team shall have the following functions:

1. Investigate the alleged existence of title(s) covering a portion of the national park and determine the authenticity of such title(s).
2. Determine the area allegedly covered by such title(s).
3. Determine existence of other illegal transactions of land affecting the national park.
4. The Team shall consult with local government units and other offices as well as non-governmental organizations who may have some information or ideas leading to the resolution or clarification of issues involving the park land.
5. Recommend action measures that will lead to the early resolution of land conflicts in the said area.

The members of the Investigating Team shall be entitled to travelling expenses subject to the usual auditing and accounting regulations, chargeable against their respective offices.

This Order takes effect immediately.
