SUBJECT : Authorizing DENR Personnel to attend
the Training for Social Forestry

2. The site monitors shall serve full time in the training program.


3. The visiting monitors shall join the evaluation and monitoring team of the Development Academy of the Philippines which has been contracted to provide this service. They shall observe the guidelines set forth by the DENR-DAP Project Management.

4. The site monitors shall monitor and evaluate the day-to-day training activities. They shall prepare weekly and terminal reports for submission to the DENR, HRD Service.

5. The site monitors for Region 9 shall join their NGO in the pre-training reorientation workshop.

6. They shall be entitled to reasonable traveling expenses in proceeding to and returning from the training sites (before and after training) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations chargeable against CARP Operational Support Fund.
