- 2. The National Seed Task Force shall have the following responsibilities and functions:
 - 2.1 Review the national situation with recard to the production of planting stocks for the National Forestation Program for 1989 and subsequent years, and recommend measures to ensure that planting stocks of sufficient quantity and quality are made available in the various regions during the planting seasons in the respective regions;
 - 2.2 Recommend measures for the sourcing of quality seeds, and the systematic distribution and handling thereof;

- 2.3 Review the status of all forest seed production areas in the country, and recommend measures for the permanent establishment and management of such areas:
- Review state-of-the-art technology on planting stock production, assess the feasibility of adopting such technologies in the country, and recommend appropriate technologies for the country:
- 2.5 Develop a program for forest tree improvement for the country;
- 3. The task force shall be assisted by a Secretariat, composed of the following personnel of the Seed and Tree Improvement Section of the Reforestation Division, Forest Management Bureau:
