**SUBJECT : CREATION OF A DENR MONITORING STATION
ALONG THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY, BARANGAY
STO. CRISTO, SARIAYA, QUEZON.**

In the interest of the service and in order to curtail the flow of illegally cut forest products from Mauban, Quezon and those gathered from the Quezon National Park which is continuously being ravaged by scrupulous loggers, a monitoring station along the National Highway, Sariaya, Quezon is hereby created.

The monitoring station shall be manned by personnel of the Personnel Investigation Committee/Special Actions and Investigation Division, DENR; members of non-governmental institution; and elements from the local PENRO in the province of Quezon. The group shall operate in coordination with the local military authorities in the area.

In the same vein, the personnel from the local PENRO who will be assigned to the monitoring station must be duly designated by the PENRO Officer of the province where the monitoring station is situated.
