


SUBJECT : DESIGNATING DESDITCHADO L. VILLASARIO
AS OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF THE RP-JAPAN
CROCODILE FARMING INSTITUTE PROJECT


1. In the interest of the service, Mr. Desditchado L. Villasario, Sr. Development and Management Officer, is hereby designated as Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of the RP-Japan Crocodile Farming Institute Project in Irawan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.
2. As OIC, he shall be under the supervision of the Undersecretary for Planning, Policy and Project Management thru the Asst. Secretary for Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects, and shall perform the following functions:
 - a. Direct and supervises the implementation of project activities in accordance with approved work and financial plans;
 - b. Establish schemes and procedures for effective and efficient project implementation consistent with the operational framework for foreign-assisted projects and to other agency regulations, guidelines, and procedures;
 - c. Review and recommend, in accordance with the operational plan, the Project's periodic work and financial programs for final approval of the Project Joint Committee;
 - d. Approve travel orders and itinerary of travel of project personnel for periods not exceeding thirty (30) days, subject to approved travel plans;
 - e. Recommend the designation as well as the removal/dismissal of project personnel;
 - f. Perform other functions as may be delegated by higher authorities pursuant to the provisions of DENR Memorandum Order No. 1 and DENR Administrative Order No. 17, Series of 1988, subject however to compliance to para. 3.4 of National Compensation Circular No. 53 dated June 21, 1988 issued by the Department of Budget and Management; and


- g. Prepare and submit periodic reports on the progress of project implementation to the Undersecretary for Planning, Policy and Project Management through the Asst. Secretary for Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects.
3. In the discharge of his functions as OIC, he shall coordinate with the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer in Palawan.
 4. He shall be entitled to reasonable transportation allowable and other allowable expenses under existing laws, rules and regulations, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
 5. This Order shall not entitle him to preferential rights to promotion.
 6. This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until such time a full-time Institute Director has been designated.


