- Review all pertinent laws, rules and regulations concerning the management and regulation of use of grazing lands and formulate the necessary amendments/modifications including implementing quidelines; and
- Study thoroughly the utilization and management of rangelands pursuant to the provisions of and formulate appropriate Constitution proposals/measures for the sustainable use thereof

The members of the Committee including its support staff shall be entitled to the reimbursement of necessary expenses that will be incurred in the prosecution of their functions chargeable against the funds of the Undersecretary for Environment and Research subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
