The Visiting Monitors shall join the Evaluation and Monitoring Team of the Development Academy of the Philippines, which has been contracted to provide this service. They shall observe the guidelines set forth by the DENR-DAP Project Management Team.

The On-Site Monitors shall serve full-time during the training program to monitor and evaluate the day-to-day training activities. They shall prepare weekly reports for submission to the HRD Service and to the DAP. ON-site monitors may be called to the Central Office from time to time for periodic consultations.

The Apprentice Monitors shall assist the On-Site Monitors in the documentation and other related funtions pertaining to the training. A separate special order shall be issued to formalize the designation of the other apprentice site monitors whose names are not included in this order.

After completion of the training program, the On-Site Monitors shall be given a one-week extension to prepare the last weekly reports, terminal report and other pertinent papers.

They shall be entitled to reasonable travelling expenses and per diems in reporting to the training sites and reporting back to Central Office, as often as may be necessary, subject to the ususal accounting and auditing regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately .
