Subject: Creation of the DENR Technical Coordinating

Committee on the Standardization of Survey

Maps and Procedures

In the interest of the service, and in view of the need to standardize survey maps and procedures under the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for consistent survey data and operations which shall be the basis for the eventual development of a Department-wide Geographic Information Systems, a DENR Technical Coordinating Committee on the Standardization of Survey Maps and Procedures is hereby created. The Committee shall lay down rules and regulations pertaining to the mechanics of a consistent handling of land surveys and mapping activities within the Department.

The Committee shall be composed of the following:

Lands Management Bureau (LMB) -- Chairman
National Mapping Resource
Information Agency (NAMRIA) -- Vice-Chairman
Forest Management Bureau (FMB) - Member
Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau (MGB) -- Member
Field Operations, DENR -- Member
Geodetic Engineers of the Phil. (GEP) -- Member

To assist the functions of the Committee, the following Sub-Committees shall likewise be created:

1. Field Surveys Sub-committee

To identify standards for accuracy, precision, instruments and field specifications to be implemented by the different agencies

Chairman ----- LMB Vice-Chairman -- MGB

2. Maps Standardization Sub-committee

To set guidelines in the preparation and use of maps, excluding special maps prepared by NAMRIA

Chairman ---- NAMRIA Vice-Chairman -- FMB

3. Administrative and Special Concerns Sub-Committee

To look into the legal, social and economic effects of the standardization procedures; to finalize the report to be submitted by the Committee

Chairman ----- Field Operation, DENR Vice-Chairman ----- GEP

The different heads of the agencies shall each issue a special order to designate his official representative, and an alternate, who shall be given authority to decide during the discussions.

All expenses incurred by the Committees shall be shouldered by the respective agencies.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
