The Committee is responsible for the preparation of a comprehensive and integrated conservation plan for the Philippine eagle, provide future coordination and direction for the PECP and ensure that exchange of communication between the PECP in Davao and UPLB, DENR, and the Peregrine Fund, Inc. is attained.

The Committee is authorized to form sub-committees on field research, captive breeding and conservation education and tap expertise outside the Steering Committee as the need arises.

Committee is authorized to avail itself of assistance and services of any employee of the DENR offices in the performance of these tasks.

The Committee shall report directly to the Undersecretary for Environment and Research.

Secretariat shall provide administrative The undertake liaison work for the Committee, prepare schedule of Committee meetings and record the minutes/proceedings Committee recommendations.

This order shall take effect immediately and supercedes, revokes or cancels all other orders and instructions inconsistent herewith.
