- conduct training programs with the intent to install the system in thirteen (13) DENR Regional Offices within a span of four (4) months and conduct 120 compliance audits over a twenty-month period;
- Provide assistance for training NGOs in the MES system concurrent with other trainings conducted in the Regions and;
- c) Revise and update the computer programs to improve overall system once it has been field tested.

The Team funding to include honoraria, travelling expenses other incidental expenses shall be charged against the ADB National Program Coordinating Office funds.
