The training will be held from March 11 to April 10, 1990 or a period of 30 training contact days. The classroom phase will be held at Villa Pansol, Calamba, Laguna. The field trips will include visits to selected natural dipterocarp forests, reforestation plantations, mangrove forests, agro-forestry sites, natural and artificial pine forests and bamboo plantation.

The training program will be conducted by the Mandala Development Corporation (MADECOR), a Los Baños-based group which has pooled pathologists, entomologists and other plant scientists from the Los Baños Science Community.

Training is live-in, including the field trips.

The expenses to be incurred in reporting to the training venue and in returning to the trainees' official stations will be chargeable against their respective regional appropriations. The expenses during the field trips are already included in the over-all training cost.

The participants are expected to submit to their respective Regional Executive Directors a report of learnings and an action plan to use their learnings after the training.
