
SUBJECT: Authorizing Personnel to attend the

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR



The "Araw ng Kababaihan" is a kick-off ceremony to
dramatize the Women's Month Celebration. This is aimed at
bringing together women from all walks of life and project
women's cause. The "Second National Congress of Women in
Government" will assess the status by which issues, problems
and recommendations raised during the First National Congress
of Women in Government had been addressed. The "Joint GO
and NGO Women's Congress will identify programs, projects and
concerns where GO's and NGO's can cooperate in relation to
the implementation of the Philippine Development Plan for
Women (PDFW).

All concerned government agencies are required to wait for invitation and corresponding guidelines from the respective secretariats of the aforementioned activities. Subject to existing government rules and regulations, participating agencies are likewise authorized to pay the registration fees of their delegates to the above duly designated secretariat to cover expenses for venue, foods, supplies and other incidental expenses and to allow the use of government vehicles or provide reasonable transportation allowance.

Participants shall submit to their respective agency head report on their attendance after the conduct activities. Likewise, the NCRFW shall submit to the OSC a report on the Congress proceedings including a list of participants indicating their respective positions and agencies within 30 days after the completion of the activities.
