SUBJECT: Creation of Study Teams for Cadastral Land Laws and Environmental and Natural Resources Laws Subcomponent of the Natural Resources Management and Development Project (NRMDP)

For effective and efficient implementation of the Land Laws Component activities as provided for in the approved Implementation Document of the Natural Resources Management and Development Project, the following subcomponent Study Teams are hereby created and shall be composed of the following DENR officials:

The above Study Teams shall perform the following tasks:

- 1. Review land tenure policy and cadastral legal structure which support the disposition of public domain lands and convey the threshold lands.
- 2. Review of laws relating to natural resources management and the protection of the environment.
- 3. Identify the major constraints and limitations in the cadastral legal system and resource management and protection of laws.
- 4. Prepare report on the status of the Philippine Cadastre and the existing natural resource management and protection legal framework.
- Evaluate options through workshops involving relevant interested parties and in evaluation studies where appropriate.
- 6. Select preferred options by a process of concensus and develop a framework for change to improve natural resource management and protection and of the level of service of the cadastre to the Philippine community.
- 7. Prepare a report on the evaluation of proposed changes.
- 8. Test and refine proposals by application to the land reform programs of CARP, ISF ancestral lands and in DENR natural resource programs.
- 9. Prepare downstream project proposals to include the drafting of proposed new laws for cadastral reform and for reform of natural resource management and protection practices.
- 10. Plan and document downstream project proposals designed to implement recommended changes.
- 11. Establish appropriate links to the GOP legislative process.

The subcomponent Study Teams shall meet as often as necessary to ensure the timely completion of the Land Laws component activity plan.

All expenses such as travels and per diem allowances as well as reimbursement of necessary expenses for the needed supplies and materials shall be drawn from the funds of the NRMDP, subject to existing budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until such time that the above subcomponent Study Teams have accomplished their tasks.
