Subject: Creation of a DENR Monitoring Committee to replace the Transition Management Committee for the Tamaraw Conservation Program (TCP).

In the interest of the service and in order to provide proper coordination and linkage between the DENR and UPLBFI in the implementation of the Tamaraw Conservation Program (TCP), a DENR Monitoring Committee to replace the Transition Management Committee for the TCP created under DENR Special Order No. 136, Series of 1990, is hereby created to be composed of the following:

3. Mr. Don Abarrientos, PAWB - Member
4. Ms. Liz Cherry Solijon, Planning, PAWB - Member
5. Ms. Lily Hua-Garcia, FASPO, DENR - Member
6. Mr. Horan Bayangan, CENRO, San Jose - Member
7. Mr. Vivencio Mitra, CENRO, Sablayan - Member

The Committee shall serve as DENR counterparts in the implementation of the TCP;

The Committee shall be responsible for the monitoring, review and evaluation of TCP activities being undertaken by the UPLBFI;

The Committee shall submit quarterly monitoring reports and recommendations concerning TCP operations to the Director, PAWB with copies furnished FASPO and PPPMO;

The Committee is authorized to avail itself of the assistance/services of any employee of the Department and/or any of its Bureaus and Offices in the pursuit of its task;

The Committee members are entitled to reasonable travelling expenses and per diems chargeable against funds of their respective Offices, subject to availability of funds and existing auditing rules and regulations.

All other maintenance and operating expenses which shall be incurred by the Committee members in the performance of their duties and responsibilities under this Order shall be chargeable against TCP funds.

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes DENR Special Order No. 136, Series of 1990.
