DENR SPECIAL ORDER No. 634 Series of 1890

SUBJECT :

Deputizing two (2) Officers of the International Coordinating and Advisory Group (ICAG), Palawan Chapter as Forest Officers of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources

Pursuant to Section 80 of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, the following are hereby deputized as Forest Officers to exercise the power of authority provided for in the aforecited law within the Province of Palawan under the supervision and control of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (PENRO) of said province effective upon receipt hereof of which this Office shall be informed accordingly:

By virtue of this deputation, they are authorized to detect/investigate violations of forestry laws, rules and regulations administered by the Forest Management Bureau and to arrest even without warrant any person who has committed, is committing or is about to commit in their presence any of the offenses defined in Chapter IV of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended within their territorial jurisdiction.

They are also authorized to seize/confiscate the tools and equipment used in committing the offense and the forest products cut, gathered or removed by the offenders in the process of committing the offense. In all instances of detection, arrest and/on seizure or confiscation, they shall deliver within the period prescribed by law from the time of arrest and seizure the offender and confiscated forest products, tools and equipment and conduct preliminary investigation and file the information in court through the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer concerned.

They are further authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgement in official matters connected with the functions of their office and to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the authority of the Revised Forestry Code, as amended and its implementing rules and regulations.

They shall submit to the PENR Officer concerned a monthly report of the cases they have handled pursuant to this deputation order.

This deputation shall expire on December 31, 1990 unless sooner revoked by this Office.
