



SUBJECT: Creation of a Team to Investigate the Alleged Graft and Corrupt Practices Going-on at the RP-Japan Forestry Development Project-Watershed Management in Carranglan, Nueva Ecija

1. In the interest of the service and to clarify the issues concerning the implementation of the above-mentioned Project, a Team is hereby created to investigate the alleged graft and corrupt practices going-on at the Project, composed of the following:
 1. Atty. Victor Gapusan, PIC - Chairman
 2. Legal Service Representative- Member
 3. Mr. Francisco Altarejos,
Lizon Operations - Member
 4. Mr. Jess Jarifo, FASPO - Member
 5. Ms. Linda Mangila, R-S - Member
2. The above-mentioned personnel shall conduct the investigation at the soonest time possible and shall submit their findings and recommendations five (5) working days after the completion of the investigation.
3. They shall coordinate with the PCMS, FASPO for the necessary assistance in the conduct of said investigation.
4. They shall be entitled to reasonable travelling expenses, chargeable against the funds of the RP-Japan Forestry Development Project-Watershed management, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force during the conduct of the investigation.
