Deputizing Bantay Gubat Task Force in Region IX-B3, Ipil, Zamboanga del Sur as Forest Officers of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources

Pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, the following Bantay Gubat Task Force in Region IX, Zamboanga City, are hereby deputized as Forest Officers of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, effective upon the date of their appointment. Their Office shall be in Ipil, Zamboanga del Sur.

By virtue of this appointment, they are authorized to investigate violations of forestry laws, rules and regulations and to arrest even without warrant any person who has committed or is committing or is about to commit or who is concealing any of the offenses defined in the said law or regulations. Section No. 705 as amended with its implementing provisions.

They are also authorized to impound and use tools and equipment used in committing the offense and the forest products cut, gathered or removed by the offenders in the process of committing the offense. In all instances, the Government, through either directly or through their duly authorized representatives, shall be responsible by law from the date of arrest and seizure, and

offender(s) and confiscated forest products, tools and equipment, including the conveyance/s used and file the proper complaint with the appropriate officials designated by law to conduct preliminary investigation and file the information in court through the RD/PSNRD/DENRD concerned.

They are further authorized to administer oaths and take acknowledgments in official matters connected with the functions of their Office and to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the authority of the Revised Forestry Code, as amended and its implementing rules and regulations.

They shall submit to the RD concerned, thru the PSNRD/DENRD a monthly report of the cases they have handled pursuant to this deputization order.

This deputization shall expire on December 31, 1990 or until sooner revoked by this Office.
