SUBJECT

Amending DENR S.O. No. 1029 S. 1989 <u>designating</u> <u>Forester Remedios</u> S. <u>Evanqelista</u> <u>as Community</u> Organizing Coordinating Officer, and Angelita <u>v.</u> <u>Racelis</u> and Rosalie A. Imperial <u>to</u> <u>compose</u> the <u>Process</u> <u>Monitoring</u> <u>Team</u> for <u>Liquicia, Caba, la Union</u> <u>Upland Development Program.</u>

- 1. In the interest of the service and in view of the transfer of the Community Organizing Coordinating Officer (COCO), Ms. Ma. Amelita Tamayo and in order not to disrupt the activities of the Program, Forester Remedios S. Evangelista is hereby designated as COCO vice Forester Tamayo.
- 2. As COCO, Forester Evangelista shall perform the duties and responsibilities inherent to the position.
- 3. Likewise, in view of the discontinuance of the Process Monitoring of the UDP sites in R-4 Mindoro, and Region 3, Zambales, the documentation of project activities in Region 1, Caba, La Union shall be undertaken by a team of two composed of Foresters Angelita V. Racelis and Rosalie A. Imperial.
- 4. Foresters Racelis and Imperial shall continue performing the duties and responsibilites stipulated in Item 2 of DENR S.O. No. 1029 series of 1989.
- 5. They shall be entitled to a reasonable subsistence allowance, travelling and other incidental expenses incurred in compliance of this Order chargeable against the DENR Upland Development Trust Fund.
  - 6. This Order takes effect immediately.
