SUBJECT: Authorizing DENR Personnel to go on Fieldwork to CAR and Regions I, II and III from March 3-16, 1991 in line with the DENR Livelihood Program for Earthquake Victims

In the interest of the service and in order to ensure the smooth implementation of the P 51.00 million DENR Livelihood Program for the Earthquake Victims of CAR and Regions I, II and III, the following are hereby authorized to go to the project sites from March 3-16, 1991 to generate/establish benchmark information for monitoring the project:

Specifically, the groups shall:

1. Brief the field implementors of the monitoring and reporting requirements of the Task Force on Rehabilitation.
2. Assist the field implementors in preparing the necessary documents to facilitate future monitoring activities, e.g. project maps, detailed project plans, list of actual beneficiaries, etc.
3. Visit the proposed project sites to ensure that the project plans prepared are feasible.
4. Conduct sampling survey of the targeted beneficiaries.

In complying with the above, they shall coordinate with the REDs, PENROs and CENROs concerned. In line with this, the REDs, PENROs and CENROs concerned are hereby instructed to extend necessary assistance to the groups by providing the required information and the needed manpower support.

Upon return, the groups shall submit a report to the Undersecretary for Planning, Policy and Project Management through the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Policy Studies.


Expenses to be incurred by the groups shall be chargeable against the appropriation of their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately.
