The composition of the Inter-Agency Committee shall henceforth be as follows:


Assistant Director, PAWB - Chairman

SUBJECT :

Creation of an Inter-Agency Committee to Evaluate Wildlife Permit Applications and Allocation of Quota.

In view of DENR Administrative Orders No. 90, dated 22 November 1988, and No. 96, dated 19 December 1988, and in order to expedite the allocation of the annual quota for the collection and exportation of Philippine wildlife resources, an Inter-Agency Committee is hereby created composed of the following:

1) Samuel Penafiel - Chairman

2) Wilbor Dee - Vice-Chsirman

3) br. Corazon Sinha - Member (DENR Region 4)

4) Carlo Custodio - Member (PAWB)
5) Manuel Bravo - Member (ERDB)

3) Lilybath Natividad - Member (Wildlife Foundation

of the Philippines)

9) Representative from the - Member wildlife exporters group.

The Committee is hereby tasked with the following functions, daties and responsibilities:

- 1) Evaluate and assess the over-all performance of permittees, including their holding and breeding facilities;
- 2) Determine the sound bases for allocating the yearly national quota among the qualified permittees;
- 3) Determine the yearly national quota for species listed in Appendices II and III of the CITES and those wildlife species not listed therein which may still be allowed for trade;
- 4) Determine the allowable quota for wildlife to be devoted to the captive-breeding program of each qualified permittee; and
- 5) Prepare and submit appropriate recommendations and resolutions to the Secretary relative to the foregoing matters.

The Committee members shall be entitled to an honorarium of P500.00 per meeting attended chargeable against the funds of the Department, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and supercedes/amends all previous instructions inconsistent herewith.
