- 2. The Regional M&E Team shall have the following functions:
 - a) Undertake actual/onsite monitoring and evaluation of all DENR Upland Development Program/projects following the prescribed M&E guidelines and procedures;
 - b) Collect, analyże and process information and project data;
 - c) Prepare and submit semestral M&E reports and recommendations to the Undersecretary for Field Operations and Concurrent Chairman, DENR-UDP through the UDWG Executive Secretary, FMB, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City.
- 3. The Regional Office representative shall act as Chairman of the Regional Monitoring and Evaluation Team and shall initiate and spearhead in planning out all the activities related to M&E. Moreover, in addition to the above-stated functions, the duties of each individual member shall be defined as follows:
 - Regional As chairman of the Regional M&E Team, shall present the reports during RUDC meeting and endorse the final reports duly concurred by the RUDC Chairman to the Central Office; through the UDP PSS, FMB, Visayas Avenue, Quezon City, and conduct on site M&E together with the PENRO and CENRO members;
 - PENRO member- shall take charge in the thorough evaluation of logistics such as utilization of project funds specifying its fund use and other related financial matters; and conduct on site M&E together with the Regional and CENRO representative;

CENRO member— shall be responsible for the continuous monitoring of project activities in as much as s/he has direct contact with the FCO and the project, give feedback reports to the Regional and PENRO representatives prior to the team's scheduled M&E and conduct on site M&E together with the Regional and PENRO representatives.

4. Immediatelty after the M&E training, the team shall draw out strategies that would facilitate the conduct of M&E. Initially, they shall be guided by the following schedules:

1st week of April 1991 - secondary data gathering/preparation of Travel Orders, other administrative concerns.

2nd week of April 1991 - conduct of actual or on- site M&E.

3rd week of April 1991 - preparation of reports/writing and submission

However, succeeding M&E activities shall be conducted every six (6) months thereafter. For better results, verification of project data may be done anytime if it deems necessary.

- 5. They shall be entitled to reasonable transportation expenses and other allowances chargeable against appropriation of their respective offices subject to the usual auditing and accounting requirements.
 - 6. This order takes effect immediately.
