SUBJECT: Creation of a DENR Counterpart Team to the Impact Evaluation of ISF Projects in Regions II, VI and X for a period of three months.

In the interest of the service, the DENR is conducting an impact evaluation of ISF Projects in coordination with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) with the assistance of the International Labor Organization (ILO)/Japan Multilateral Project.

In order to facilitate the implementation of the Project, a DENR Counterpart Team is hereby created composed of the following:

The team shall conduct field survey of CSC holders and prepare case studies for the project.

The team shall be assigned temporarily at the Regional Offices of DOLE for a period of three months under the supervision of the DOLE Regional Director. As such, they shall be relieved temporarily of their official duties and functions.

The team shall continue to receive monthly compensation from their respective offices. Travelling allowance shall be provided by the ILO/Japan Project through the DOLE.

The Regional Offices concerned shall provide vehicles, whenever available, to the team. The DOLE shall provide gasoline for the vehicles and per diems of the drivers.


A monthly progress report shall be prepared jointly by the DENR & DOLE teams to provide an update on the status of the evaluation. They shall furnish a copy of the report to the following:

ILO/Japan Multilateral Project


The team shall abide with the provisions embodied in the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between DENR and DOLE.
