Subject: Creation of Composite Teams to Undertake Land

Capability Evaluation and Survey of Work for Low-Income Upland Communities Project - Or. Mindoro

In the interest of the service and to accelerate the conduct of land capability evaluations, surveys and issuance of land tenure instruments (CSC/CFSA) in watershed areas covered by the ADB-funded Low-Income Upland Communities Project (LIUCP) in Oriental Mindoro, there is hereby created four (4) Composite Teams to perform the regular tasks of land capability evaluations, surveys and titling. The Teams shall report directly to the respective CENROS. However, their actual land capability evaluation and surveying activities in the Project areas shall be directly supervised by the Provincial Project Management Office (PPMO) Oriental Mindoro.

The DENR Region IV Office, PENROs and CENROs are hereby enjoined to provide the necessary support to the Teams to facilitate land surveys and titling.

The Team members shall be entitled to claim travel allowances and per diems chargeable against the Project funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and repeals, supersedes or revokes any orders or issuance not consistent herewith.
