The aforecited teams are hereby tasked to undertake the following activities, to wit:

 To verify the status of endemic seeds delivered by Zeta Beta Rho Foundation, Inc. and exotic seeds from Sabah, Malaysia, specifying the following:

- 1.1 volume of seeds distributed to private entities/ individuals, CENROs/PENROs and contractors;
- 1.2 volume of seeds sown/planted;
- 1.3 volume of seeds damaged and causes of damage;
- 1.4 volume of seeds stored and status of its viability;
- 1.5 No. 'or percentage of seedlings germinated both for exotic and endemic seeds.
- To discuss with the RED concerning the functions of the Regional Seed Task Force in the implementation of Seed Production Areas (SPAs);
- 3. To acqauaint/convey the Monitoring and Evaluation System for SPA to the Regional Seed Task Force.

In view hereof, the DENR personnel particulary the Regional Seed Task Force are enjoined to extend their full cooperation and support to the team while in pursuit of these tasks.

Upon completion of the mission, same are, to return to their respective Offices and submit report within five (5) days upon arrival and a summary report and recommendation for action shall be consolidated by the National Seed Task Force and shall be submitted to NPCO for further action.

The travelling expenses and per diem to be incurred for this travel shall be charged against the National Forestation Program (NFP) funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect until after the completion of the mission.
