SUBJECT : Designating DENR Permanent Representatives to the  
Different Sub-Committees Under the Cabinet Committee on  
the Law of the Sea

In the interest of the service and in pursuance to Section 2 of Executive Order 328 entitled, "Reconstituting the Cabinet Committee on the Law of the Sea," the following officials are hereby designated as permanent DENR representatives to the different Sub-Committees on the Law of the Sea:


Sub-Committee on Legal Studies	Atty. Antonio Elum Service Chief, Legal Affairs

The DENR officials representing the above stated Sub-Committees shall respectively undertake the following tasks:

1. To effectively coordinate in the formulation of laws, rules and regulations, to implement the provisions of the Law of the Sea Convention (LOSC) and to harmonize its provisions with all Philippine laws relating to the marine and coastal areas.
2. To undertake activities relevant to DENR in the preparation and conduct of maritime boundary negotiation and help recommend Philippine position papers needed by various international bodies relating to the Law of the Sea.
3. To help develop and implement integrated economic, environmental, and social development plans and policies for the country's coastal areas.
4. To coordinate in the preparation and implementation of an integrated administrative, regulatory and enforcement system for the coastal and marine areas.

All expenses to be incurred in connection with the activities of the aforementioned committee shall be chargeable against DENR funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

This order shall take effect immediately.
