SUBJECT:

Deputizing Certain Personnel of St. Paul National Park Project Under the Debt-for-Nature Swap Program as Forest Officers of the Department of

Environment and Natural Resources.

Pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order No. 192 and Presidential Decree 705, as amended, the following personnel of St. Paul National Park Project under the Debt-for-Nature Swap Program are hereby deputized as Forest Officers of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources:

By virtue of this deputation, the named project personnel shall be authorized to detect and investigate violations of forestry laws, rules, and regulations; and to arrest even without warrant any person(s) who has committed, is committing or about to commit any of the offenses defined in the Revised Forestry Code within the jurisdiction of the National Park.

The named personnel shall be authorized to seize and confiscate the tools and equipment used in committing the offense and the forest products cut, gathered or removed by the offender(s) in the process of the illegal activity.

These personnel shall be authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgment in official matters connected with their functions in the project, and to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the authority of the Revised Forestry Code and its implementing rules and regulations.

The Project Leader of St. Paul National Park shall provide the Offices of the Undersecretary for Field Operations and Undersecretary for Environment and Research with quarterly reports of the cases, if any, handled by the project pursuant to this deputation order.

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes previously issued DENR Administrative Orders to this effect, and shall remain in force until December 31, 1991 or unless otherwise revoked or amended in writing by the appropriate DENR authorities.
