Subject: Creation of an Inter-Agency Committee
Tasked to Conduct a Study on the Imposition
of Conservation Fees/Charges on Wildlife

In the interest of the service and in line with the policy mandated by Presidential Memorandum Order No. 298 dated June 14, 1990, an Inter-Agency Committee is hereby created to conduct a study on the imposition of conservation fees/charges collectible in relation to wildlife trade. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

1. RTD Celso Diaz - Chairman
2. Carlo Custodio - Vice-chairman
3. Julius Leo Saguiguit - Member (PAWB)
4. Pio Bote - Member (FMB)
5. Merlyn Rivera - Member (ERDB)
6. Representative from EMB
7. Representative from PEBAP

The study group shall be charged with the following functions and responsibilities:

1. Coordinate with other government agencies and institutions in gathering data relevant to the study
2. Analyze/evaluate economic and management feasibilities of charging conservation fees from wildlife in consultation with the industry directly affected.
3. Submit recommendations on the results of the study to the Office of the Secretary and Undersecretary for Environment and Research, DENR within 120 days upon approval of this Order.

Expenses to be incurred in pursuit of the objectives of this Order shall be chargeable from PAWB funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until the completion of the study.
