SUBJECT: <u>Deputizing two (2) Military Officials of 31B, 6ID, Philippine Army, Malibo Tantangan and Kablon, Tupi, South Cotabato</u>

Pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, and LOI No. 550 and inorder to assist the DENR in curbing/stopping timber smuggling and all other illegal activities involving destruction, and exploitation of the natural resources in Region XI as recommended by OIC, Regional Technical Director Gregorio T. Estrada and OIC, Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer Wilfredo D. Nanipon, the following are hereby deputized as Forest Officers of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, effective upon taking their oath of office:

- 1. Major Conrado V. Bermudez
- 2. Captain Fred B. Balleras

By virtue of this deputation, they are authorized to detect/investigate violations of forestry laws, rules and regulations and to arrest even without warrant any person who has committed, is committing or is about to commit in their presence any of the offenses defined in Chapter IV of Presidential Decree No. 705 as amended within their territorial jurisdiction.

They are also authorized to seize/confiscate the tools and equipment used in committing the offense and the forest products cut, gathered or removed by the offender(s) in the process of committing the offense. In all instances of detection, arrest and/or seizure or confiscation they shall deliver within period as prescribed by law from the time of arrest and seizure, the offender(s) and confiscated forest products, tools and equipment, including the conveyance/s used and file the proper complaint with the appropriate officials designated by law to conduct preliminary investigation and file the information in court through the RED/PENRO/CENRO concerned.

They are further authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgement in official matters connected with the functions of their Office and to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the authority of the Revised Forestry Code, as amended and its implementing rules and regulations.

They shall submit to the RED concerned, thru the PENRO/CENRO a monthly report of the cases they have handled pursuant to this deputation order.

This deputation shall expire on December 31, 1991 or until sooner revoked by this Office.
