SUBJECT: Creation of a Multiagency Task Force to look into the illegal titling of Friar Lands.

Consistent with the demand from various sectors to look into the alleged illegal titling of Friar Lands and in line with the desire of top management to be more effective in the acceleration of the disposition of Friar Lands, there is hereby created a Task Force composed of the following:

As created the Task Force shall perform the following activities functions:

1. Conduct an inventory and collate all existing legislations, rules and regulations pertaining to the disposition and management of Friar Lands;

2. Study and formulate solutions to major problems affecting Friar Lands titling which can be traced to some gaps in the legislation or actual regulations;

3. Revised and update rules and regulations affecting the management and disposition of Friar Lands and pinpoint areas for reform by way of improving existing legislation or by introducing new provisions which could be incorporated into legislative enactment or in the implementing rules and regulations enforced by the Land Management Bureau;

4. Provide an insight into the kind of reform that need to be initiated to rectify the abuses in the disposition and titling and disposition of Friar Lands to prevent their recurrence in the future; and

5. The Task Force may call on any official or employee for assistance it may require in the performance of its assigned tasks. They shall be authorized to organize, dialogue and to travel within the country.

Expenses incurred in the performance of their functions and remuneration to which they are entitled comensurate to the tasks they perform shall be chargeable against their respective Offices subject to auditing rules and regulations.

This Order is for the good of public service and shall take effect immediately.
