

In the interest of the service and in view of Project Director GERARDO V. ORTEGA's attendance to the Counterpart Training Program in Japan, MR. DESDITCHADO S. 
Pursuant to Executive Order No. 367 dated August 21, 1989, Messrs. **GERARDO V. ORTEGA** and **MANSUETO C.
